HB 6379

AN ACT DELAYING THE ESTABLISHMENT OF THE DEPARTMENT ON AGING.

SUMMARY:

This bill postpones the establishment of the Department on Aging for two years, until July 1, 2013. It requires the Department of Social Services (DSS) to administer aging programs until a commissioner is appointed and administrative staff are hired. It permits the governor, with Finance Advisory Committee approval, to transfer funds between DSS and the Aging Department in FY 14. The bill also makes several technical and conforming changes.

EFFECTIVE DATE: July 1, 2011 except for certain technical and conforming changes which take effect July 1, 2013.
