

COMMISSION ON CONNECTICUT'S DEVELOPMENT AND FUTURE (CCDF)

Citation: PA 21-29 s.13

Effective Date: 06/10/21 Updated 1.2.2023

Composition: 36 Members

General Member Qualifications: Appointing authorities, in cooperation with one another, shall make a good faith effort to ensure that, to the extent possible, the membership of the commission closely reflects the gender and racial diversity of the state.

General Info: The commission is within the Legislative Department. The cochairpersons shall schedule the first meeting of the commission. The commission may accept administrative support and technical and research assistance from outside organizations and employees of the Joint Committee on Legislative Management. The cochairpersons may establish, as needed, working groups consisting of commission members and nonmembers and may designate a chairperson of each such working group.

Chair Info: The Speaker of the House and the Senate President Pro Tempore shall jointly select one of their appointees to serve as one cochairperson of the commission. The Secretary of the Office of Policy and Management shall serve as the other cochairperson of the commission.

Compensation: Members of the commission shall serve without compensation, except for necessary expenses incurred in the performance of their duties.

Reporting Requirements: Not later than January 1, 2022, and not later than January 1, 2023, the commission shall submit a report to the Planning and Development, Environment, Housing and Transportation committees and to the Secretary of the Office of Policy and Management, in accordance with the provisions of CGS 11-4a. If the commission is unable to meet the first reporting deadline, the cochairpersons must request an extension from the Speaker of House and Senate President Pro Tempore.

Terms: None specified; coterminous under CGS 4-1a. Any vacancy shall be filled by the appointing authority.

Expected Termination: The commission shall terminate on the date it submits its final report or January 1, 2023, whichever is later
