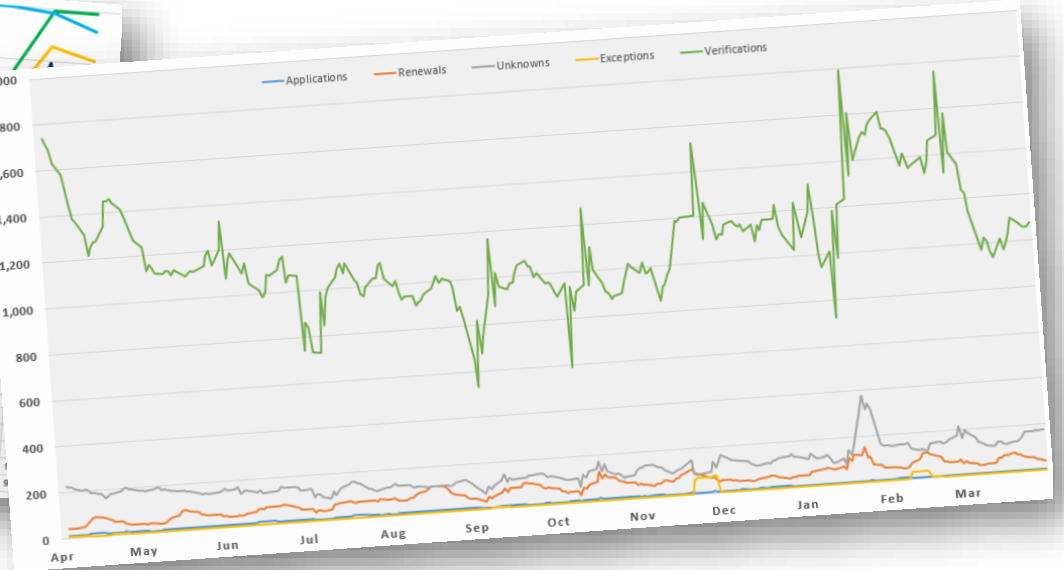

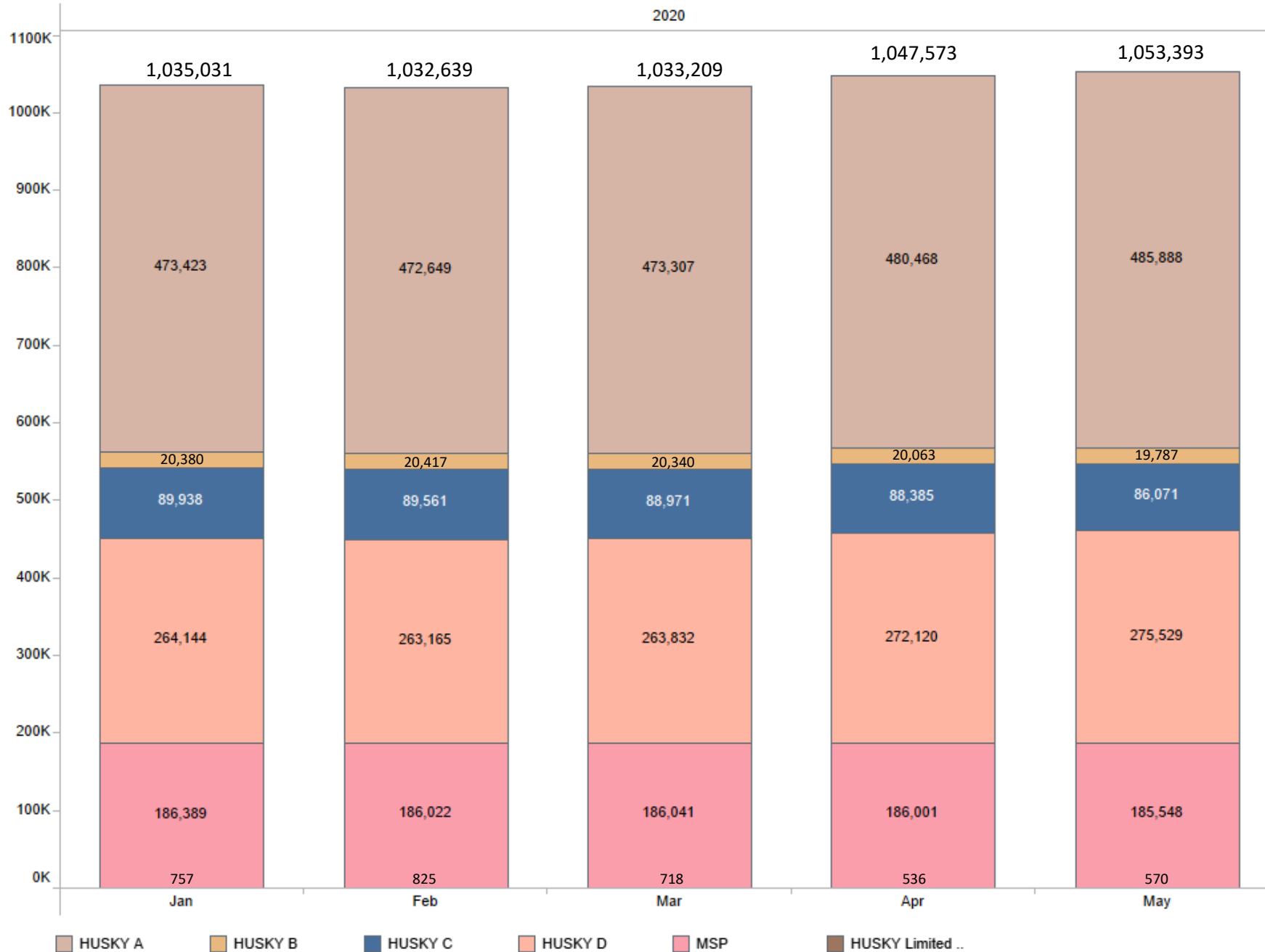

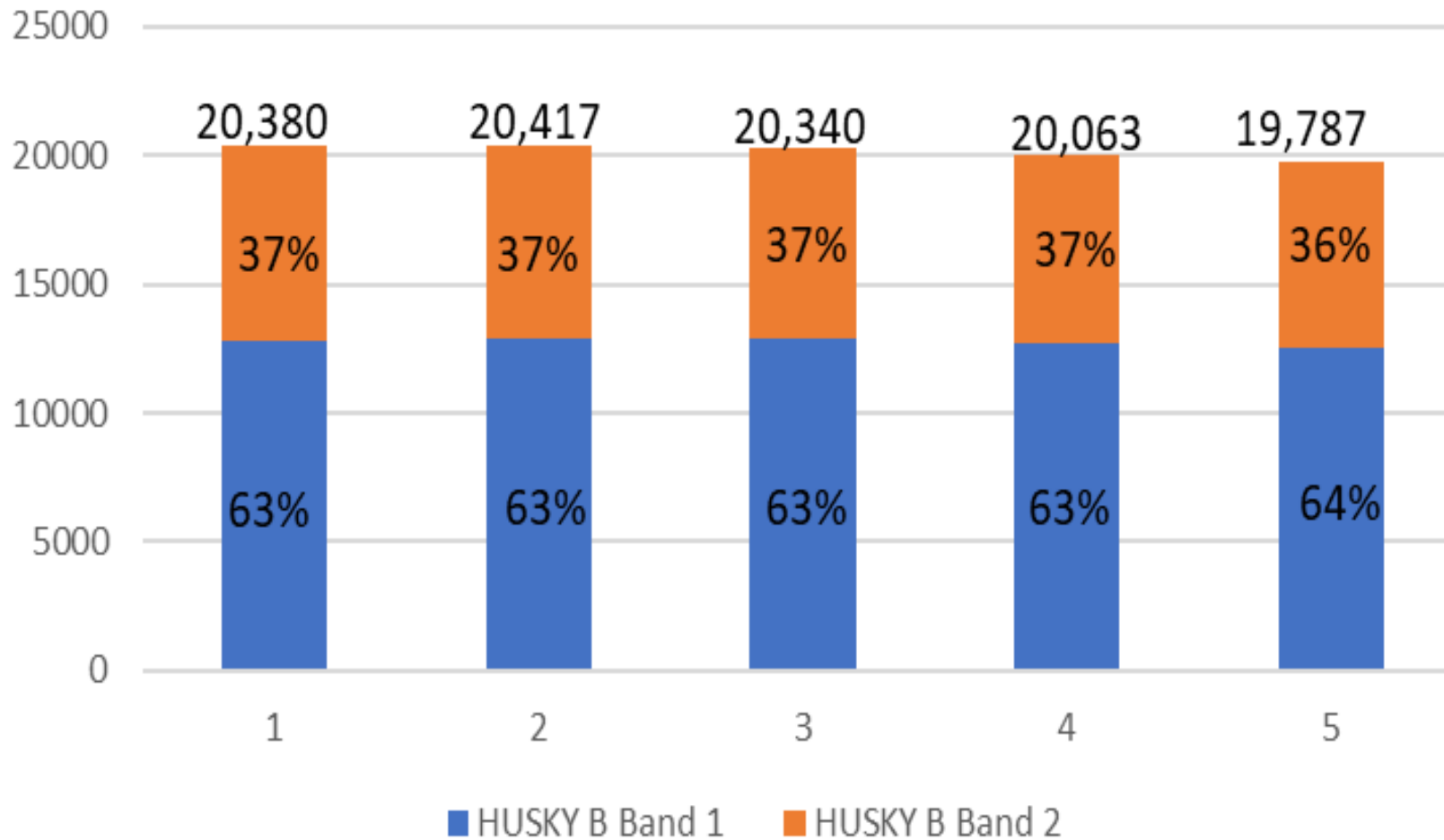
The enrollment counts shown here are for HUSKY, HUSKY Limited Benefits and MSP.

HUSKY includes:

- HUSKY A –Medicaid for children, parents, pregnant women, etc.
- HUSKY B –Children’s Health Insurance Program (CHIP)
- HUSKY C –Medicaid for the aged, blind and disabled
- HUSKY D –Medicaid for low income adults
- HUSKY LB - Family Planning (FP), FP Presumptive Eligibility and Tuberculosis

HUSKY Limited Benefit groups are identified in the figure at the bottom of each bar chart (i.e., 570 enrolled in May)

## HUSKY B - Children's Health Insurance Program



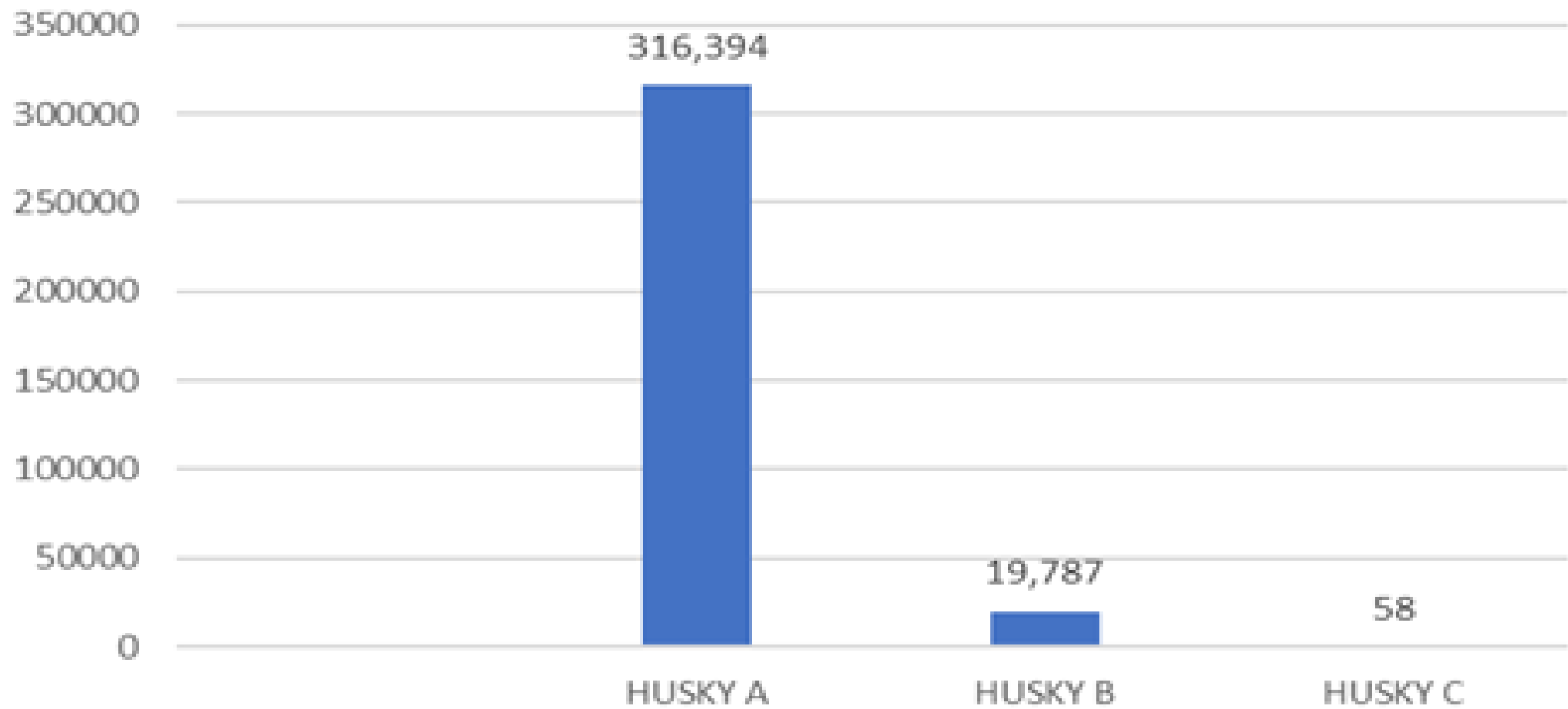
HUSKY B Band 1 – uninsured children in families with income between 201% FPL - 254% FPL

HUSKY B Band 2 – uninsured children in families with income between 254% FPL – 323% FPL

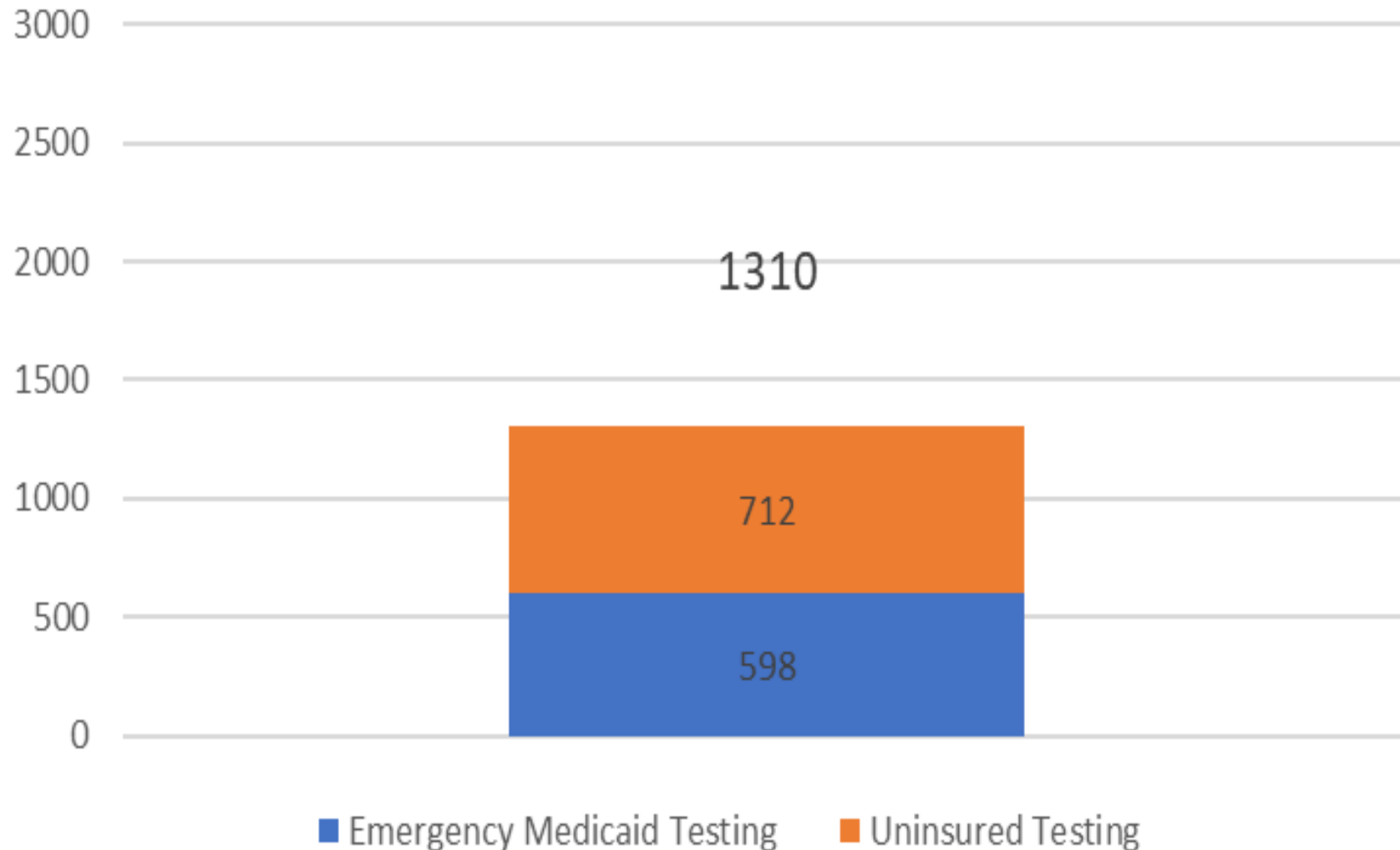

## May 2020 HUSKY A, B & C Children Enrollment

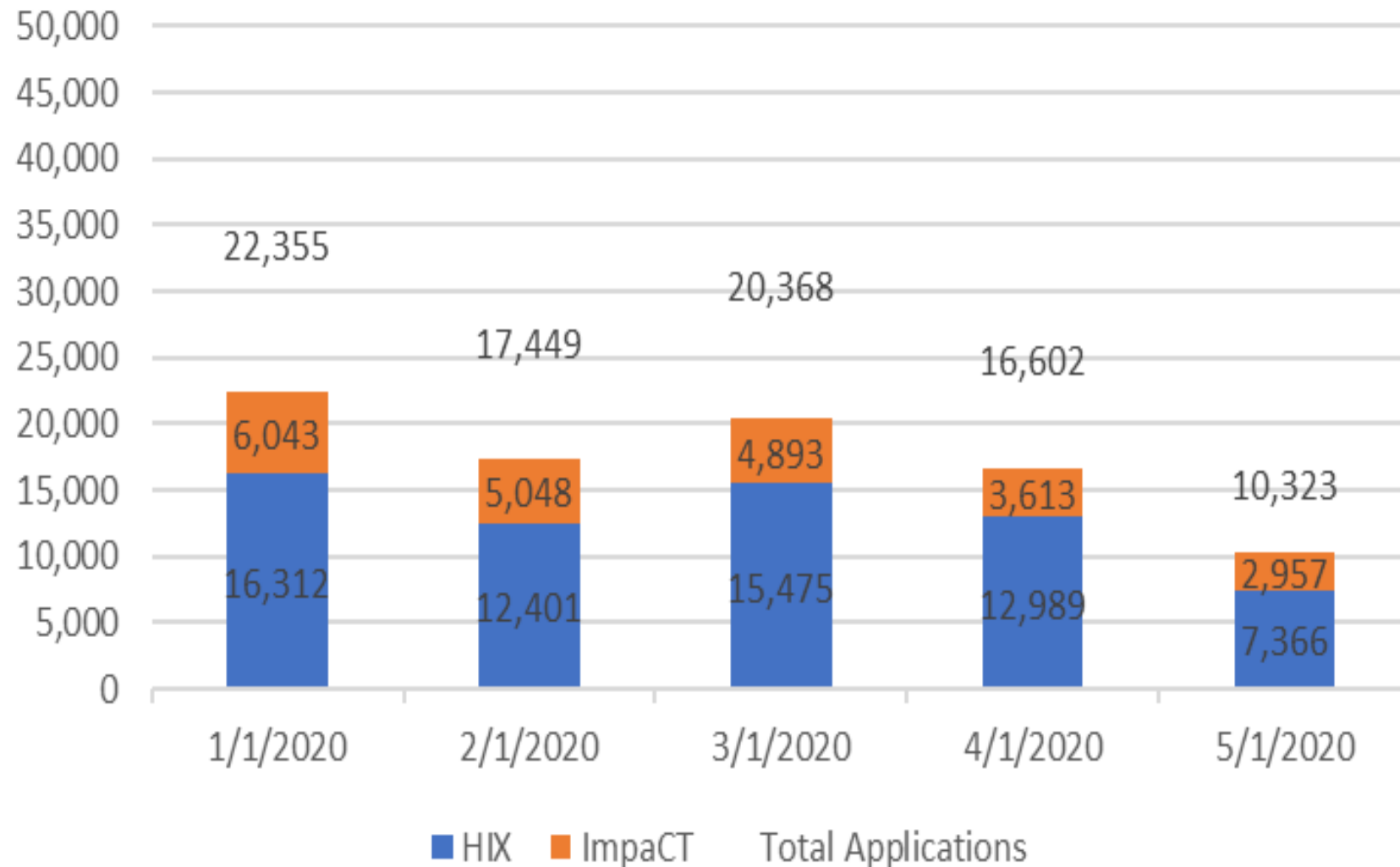


## COVID-19 Testing Coverage 3/18/20 - 6/12/20



- Medicaid for the Uninsured COVID-19 Testing Coverage Group – Uninsured CT resident citizens and qualifying non-citizens. No income limits.
- Emergency Medicaid Testing – CT residents who meet Medicaid financial eligibility requirements but do not qualify for full Medicaid due to their immigration status, including undocumented individuals.
- Most enrollees are parents/caretakers of enrolled children.

# Medical Applications 2020



This is a count of the applications, with a filing (application) date in the month and:

- Application status is in process or determined (not inactive or canceled);
- Application is not a change, renewal or in the renewal reconsideration period.

This includes all HUSKY and MSP applications.

HIX represents single streamlined applications for HUSKY A, B and D processed in the shared system with AHCT. HUSKY C and other medical program applications are processed in DSS's ImpaCT system.
