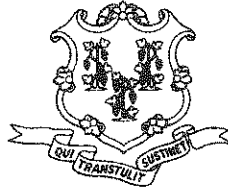

Task Force To Study The Provision Of Behavioral Health Services For Young Adults

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Data Needed for Mental Health Task Force

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SCOPE OF THE PROBLEM

- Prevalence Rate in Connecticut youth and young adult 13-24 years old of:
 - Death by suicide rate per 100,000 youths
 - Depression rate per 100,000 youths
 - ADHD rate per 100,000 youths
 - DCF reported abuse and neglect
- Prevalence rate of Emergency Dept. use for psychiatric care
 - What % of all ED visits are for mental health treatment in CT?
- What % of CT youth 13-24 years old with a mental health problem has access to mental health treatment or actually receive psychiatric care?
- What is the arrest rate per 100,000 CT youth ages 13-24 years?
 - % arrested with mental health/psychiatric diagnosis or past treatment history
 - % with comorbid Substance Use Disorder
 - % at entry to Juvenile Justice with a history of PTSD or traumatic stress
- What is the number of firearms in Connecticut per 100,000 population? Compare with national norms.
