Adolescent Health Care

Information Forum and Public Hearing

The Legislative Program Review and Investigations Committee is conducting a study of the state's **Adolescent Health Care** system using a results-based accountability (RBA) approach. As part of this study, the committee has scheduled an information forum and a public hearing for **Tuesday, June 21, 2011**, in Room 2D of the Legislative Office Building. The forum will begin at 10:00 a.m. and the public hearing will start at 1:00 p.m.

The forum will be a two-hour round-table discussion with invited panelists including state agency officials, health care professionals, and advocates with pertinent roles in adolescent health. The committee will receive input and comments from all interested parties at the afternoon public hearing.

The program review committee is seeking feedback about how well the state's system of primary and preventive medical, behavioral, and oral health care for adolescents is working. PRI also would like to hear suggestions on ways the legislature can improve and promote the health of Connecticut youth ages 10-19.
