

OFA AMENDED BILL ANALYSIS

SSB 460 (as amended by Senate "A")

AN ACT CONCERNING THE DISCLOSURE OF INFORMATION MAINTAINED BY PUBLIC AGENCIES TO THE COMMISSIONER OF REVENUE SERVICES

SUMMARY: The bill as amended requires that on or before 7/1/96, all applicants for any state license must provide their Connecticut tax registration number and federal social security account number or federal employee identification number, as part of their license registration. All state agencies must furnish the Department of Revenue Services with this information on or before 2/1/97. The bill provides that licensees who have not filed state tax returns or paid taxes have their license suspended or revoked after being notified and given a hearing. Agencies may also refuse to reissue or renew licenses under these circumstances. The bill applies similar information requirements to persons selling goods or services, or leasing property to the state, on or before 7/1/96. If such people have not filed returns or paid taxes, the bill requires that their contracts not be renewed or extended.

Senate "A" requires the Commissioner of Health Services to take the best interest of the State into consideration when determining whether to refuse to reissue, renew or extend licenses of child day care or nursing home facilities with delinquent State tax returns.
