

OFA BILL ANALYSIS

SB 2003

AN ACT CONCERNING THE CONNECTICUT WING CIVIL AIR PATROL, OFFICE OF EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT, THE BUREAU OF STATE-WIDE EMERGENCY TELECOMMUNICATIONS AND REIMBURSEMENT FOR STATE TROOPERS

SUMMARY: This bill consolidates three public safety-related agencies into the Department of Public Safety. The agencies to be consolidated are the Connecticut Wing-Civil Air Patrol, the Office of Emergency Management, and the Bureau of State-Wide Emergency Telecommunications.

The bill also increases the charges to municipalities for the Resident State Trooper program from the 70% rate, to 75%, effective July 1, 1992.
