EXPLANATION OF ESTIMATES:

STATE IMPACT: The passage of the bill would result in a potential minimal cost, which can be absorbed, to the Judicial Department. To the extent that other states which have adopted the Act file claims in Superior Court against alleged polluters in Connecticut, court caseloads would increase. Although the degree of additional caseload and associated cost cannot be quantified, it is anticipated that these cases will be minimal and can be absorbed within normal budgetary resources.
