TITLE: "AN ACT CONCERNING THE TASK FORCE TO STUDY SAFETY IN THE WORKPLACE AND THE TASK FORCE TO STUDY INTERSTATE OCCUPATIONAL LICENSING REQUIREMENTS"

SUMMARY: The bill extends reporting deadlines for two task forces. The task force to study safety in the workplace and the task force to study interstate occupational licensing would report no later than January 1, 1993. Currently, the reporting deadlines are no later than February 1, 1992 for the task force on work place safety and February 15, 1992 for the task force on interstate occupational licensing.
