EXPLANATION OF ESTIMATES:

STATE IMPACT: Passage of the bill requires the labor commissioner to adopt regulations to implement the bill. It is anticipated that this can be done within the normal budgetary resources of the Labor Department.

MUNICIPAL IMPACT: Passage of the bill calls for municipalities with 50 or more employees to establish health and safety committees. This administrative mandate would require the diversions of existing personnel resources. It is anticipated that the work of such committees could prevent job-related illness and accidents and thereby result in both savings and higher productivity.
