EXPLANATION OF ESTIMATES:

STATE IMPACT: The passage of this bill could result in additional minimal costs to the Department of Labor that cannot be determined at this time. This bill extends the State's 1991 "Right to Act" law to cover state and municipal employees. Minimal costs could result to the Department of Labor from promulgating regulations covering public employees and from investigating and adjudicating additional cases. The number of additional cases is anticipated to be minimal.
