EXPLANATION OF ESTIMATES:

STATE IMPACT: The Refunds of Payments account administered by the State Comptroller, within SHB 5100 (the Appropriations Act, as favorably reported from the Appropriations Committee) reflects the non-refunding provisions of this bill. The bill would prohibit the Commissioner of the Department of Environmental Protection from authorizing a refund, with 3 exceptions, for the cancellation of a campsite lease. The savings reflected in the budget is anticipated to be \$6,000 to \$10,000 a year. This figure does not take into account the 3 exceptions and the potential for a reasonable service charge added by the Environment Committee. It is not anticipated that these changes will significantly alter the original estimate based on past experience.
