EXPLANATION OF ESTIMATES:

The bill precludes a cost to the state of \$186,200 in FY 1992-93 from the delay of one year in the effective date (January 1, 1993 to January 1, 1994) of the Connecticut Appeals Board for Property Valuation. There is no fiscal impact from eliminating the State Employees Group Insurance Commission as no funds have been appropriated or expended for this function to date.
