EXPLANATION OF ESTIMATES:

STATE IMPACT: The passage of this bill would result in minimal additional costs to the Department of Public Works that would be absorbed within existing resources. The bill requires the Department of Public Works (DPW) to review its bidding and contract procedures, with the objective of streamlining them while continuing to protect the public interest. DPW is required to report to the General Assembly by January 1, 1993. This would result in minimal costs to DPW that would be absorbed within existing resources. In addition, the bill statutorily changes some of the relationships among DPW, its general contractors, subcontractors and construction managers on projects valued above \$7.5 million. These changes formalize current practices of the agency and have no fiscal impact.
