EXPLANATION OF ESTIMATES:

STATE IMPACT: Passage of the bill requires the Secretary of the Office of Policy and Management (OPM) to adopt a State Plan for the Use and Development of State-Owned Property. The bill also requires the Secretary to develop and maintain an inventory of controversial land uses including state institutions and facilities and siting council facilities. OPM would require additional staff resources to undertake the tasks specified in the bill. The level of additional resources and their cost cannot be determined at this time.

The bill requires OPM to adopt regulations. It is anticipated that the cost of adopting these regulations would be minimal and would be within the agency's budgetary resources. Additionally, OPM is to develop and annually update a map showing the locations of the facilities listed on the inventory, within available appropriations.
