EXPLANATION OF ESTIMATES:

STATE IMPACT: Since this bill, as amended, would formalize the current practice of the Department of Consumer Protection with respect to wholesalers and manufacturers of controlled substances, minimal additional costs are anticipated to result. The additional costs that are anticipated relate to the conducting of the hearings.

In addition, as the basic procedure for distribution of controlled drugs to other sources is currently in place, no additional costs are expected to result from the passage of this bill.

MUNICIPAL IMPACT: As the basic procedure for distribution of controlled drugs to other sources is currently in place, no additional costs are expected to result from the passage of this bill.

House "A" adds the provisions relating to wholesalers and manufacturers of controlled substances which resulted in minimal additional costs.
