EXPLANATION OF ESTIMATES:

STATE IMPACT: The passage of the bill would result in a short-term caseload increase to the Judicial Department that can be absorbed within normal budgetary resources. Under the bill, non-resident individuals or foreign partnerships over whom the court may exercise personal jurisdiction would be excluded from the requirement that proceedings be postponed for three months if the defendant did not file an appearance. As a result, a short-term increase in the number of cases to be adjudicated before the court would ensue, but no change in the total number of cases is expected.
