EXPLANATION OF ESTIMATES:

STATE IMPACT: The passage of this bill would result in savings to the State that are anticipated to be minimal. The bill allows the Commissioner of Administrative Services to waive the examination requirement and certify all applicants for a promotion if five or fewer people who meet the minimum qualifications apply to take a promotional exam. It allows an agency to appoint any candidate from the list who has a current satisfactory performance rating. It also allows the Commissioner to authorize the immediate promotion of the incumbent when a filled position in the classified service is reclassified to the next higher career level, as long as the person meets certain standards. These changes would reduce the number of examinations, resulting in savings that are anticipated to be minimal.
