EXPLANATION OF ESTIMATES:

There will be a minimal cost shift for the Department of Public Utility Control due to the date change by which the licensees of nuclear power generating facilities should have in decommissioning financing plans. The department may have to spend more time reviewing these plans in fiscal year 1992-93 than 1993-94. Currently, there are four nuclear power generating facilities in the State. The Department of Public Utility Control will also need more staff time to review updated plans which will be required as a result of the passage of this bill.

It is anticipated that this additional work for the Department of Public Utility Control can be handled within normal budgetary resources.

The Department of Public Utility Control is a special Fund agency that assesses the public utility companies it regulates for its funding.
