EXPLANATION OF ESTIMATES:

STATE IMPACT: The passage of this bill could result in a potential revenue gain to the State beginning in FY 1995-96 that is indeterminate. The bill repeals the prohibition on charging State employees for parking while at work at any State owned, operated, or leased parking area. It makes coalition bargaining mandatory for State employee parking privileges beginning July 1, 1994. These negotiations could result in State employees having to pay for parking. The potential revenue gain (or savings) cannot be determined at this time.
