EXPLANATION OF ESTIMATES:

The basic procedure for monitoring compliance with the State's Child Protection Act currently exists, therefore, no additional costs are expected to result for the Department of Consumer Protection from the passage of this bill.

In addition, since a fine can be imposed for violations, a revenue gain is expected to result. The extent of the revenue gain is indeterminate as it is contingent upon the number of violations that occur and the fine that is imposed, however, any revenue from fines is expected to be minimal.

Passage of this bill could result in a caseload increase to the Division of Criminal Justice and the Judicial Department. Although the extent to which violations would occur is uncertain, the number is expected to be minimal and could be handled within the normal budgetary resources of the agencies.
