EXPLANATION OF ESTIMATES:

STATE AND MUNICIPAL IMPACT: The passage of this bill as amended would result in no additional costs to the State or municipalities. The bill as amended expands the grounds for the Municipal Police Training Council's (MPTC) cancelling or revoking a municipal police officer's certificate.

House Amendment "A" eliminates the provision in the original bill that would have allowed the MPTC to refuse to issue a certificate for specified criteria, and has no fiscal impact.

House Amendment "C" eliminates the provision in the original bill that would have allowed the MPTC to revoke a certificate if the officer is convicted of a Class A or B Misdemeanor and expands the grounds to include use of a firearm in an improper manner which results in the death or serious injury of another person. This has no fiscal impact.

House Amendment "D" eliminates the provision in the original bill that would have allowed the MPTC to revoke a certificate if the officer is convicted of a violation of Section 53a-125b of the General Statutes (larceny in the sixth degree). This also has no fiscal impact.
