EXPLANATION OF ESTIMATES:

STATE IMPACT: The passage of the bill could result in a potential minimal cost to the Judicial Department related to increased caseload which could be absorbed within normal budgetary resources. Since the bill authorizes those with a record interest in property to apply to the court for a hearing to determine whether a mechanic's lien should be discharged or reduced; the number of hearings conducted by the court may increase, but are anticipated to be minimal.

In addition, a corresponding potential minimal revenue gain may result to the State due to an increase in the number of applications for discharge of liens before the court which carries a \$20 fee.
