EXPLANATION OF ESTIMATES:

STATE IMPACT: Passage of the bill, as amended, permits the Labor Department to combine the functions of paying unemployment compensation benefits and providing job referrals, which will increase administrative efficiency.

House Amendment "A" removes two exceptions which the original bill, which had a potential minimal cost, made to the law making a claimant ineligible for State extended unemployment compensation benefits if he fails to look for work.
