EXPLANATION OF ESTIMATES:

STATE IMPACT: Passage of this bill as amended will result in a minimal cost, which can be absorbed within normal budgetary resources, to the Departments of Children and Youth Services, Human Resources, and the Commission on Children. These costs would be associated with training and oversight of the municipal agents.

MUNICIPAL IMPACT: Passage of this bill as amended will result in an indeterminate fiscal impact for municipalities. Appointment of a municipal agent for children shall be subject to the discretion of the community. Those towns which choose to appoint agents may voluntarily incur costs, the magnitude of which cannot be determined at this time.

House "A" modifies the duties of a municipal agent. No fiscal impact is associated with this amendment.

House "B" removes the mandatory nature of the duties of a municipal agent. No fiscal impact is associated with this amendment.
