EXPLANATION OF ESTIMATES:

STATE IMPACT: Passage of this bill would result in a minimal cost for the Department of Health Services, which can be absorbed within the resources of their normal operating budget. It is anticipated that the costs to DOHS associated with maintaining a list of the number and type of accidents reported by licensed child day care centers and group day care homes would be minimal.

MUNICIPAL IMPACT: Passage of this bill would result in a minimal cost to municipalities. Since some licensed child day care centers and group day care homes are operated by municipalities, they would incur the minimal cost of filing the report. It should be noted that most day care facilities currently report injuries to DOHS.
