EXPLANATION OF ESTIMATES:

Since this bill primarily impacts businesses that sell or install tinted material for motor vehicle windows or tint motor vehicle windows, no impact on state agencies or municipalities is anticipated.

Enforcement of the provisions of the bill will be accomplished during the normal course of inspections conducted by inspectors in the Dealers and Repairers Division of the Department of Motor Vehicles.

Since the bill, as amended, delays for one year the requirement for motor vehicles with tinted windows to comply with light transmission and reflection standards the workload increase associated with the inspection process would not be incurred by the DMV in fiscal year 1993. Although the number of tinted vehicles that would be subject to the inspection requirement is not available, it could be substantial. Except for a \$15,000 appropriation under PA 90-210 to cover partial costs of light meters to properly test motor vehicles at existing enclosed inspection lanes, no funds were provided to carry out the provisions of the Act.

The anticipated indeterminate revenue gain from infractions imposed on any person violating the Act would also be postponed for one year.

House "B" delays for one year the requirement for motor vehicles with tinted windows to comply with light transmission standards, it would have the delayed workload increase and delayed revenue gain stated above.
