EXPLANATION OF ESTIMATES:

STATE IMPACT: The passage of this bill would not result in a fiscal impact to the State. The bill allows magistrates to waive the fee for a motion to reopen a judgment in motor vehicle cases rather than being required to transfer the case to a judge for such actions as is the current requirement. It is anticipated that this change would reduce the timeframes involved in such actions but not change the amount of revenue collected.

The bill also formalizes a current practice of the Department relating to records of magisterial proceedings and would not result in a fiscal impact.
