EXPLANATION OF ESTIMATES:

STATE IMPACT: The passage of the bill as amended could result in a potential minimal cost, which can be absorbed, to the Judicial Department's State-Wide Grievance Committee. To the extent that more grievances may be filed with the Committee relating to improper solicitation by lawyers as specified in the bill, a potential minimal cost may result but can be absorbed within normal budgetary resources.

House Amendment "A" eliminates certain requirements in the original bill but does not alter the fiscal impact as stated above.
