EXPLANATION OF ESTIMATES:

STATE IMPACT: It is anticipated that there will be additional responsibility for state agencies as a result of the passage of this bill.

Their responsibility in getting supervisors trained in the area of sexual harrassment depends to a great extent upon the regulations to be developed by the Commission on Human Rights and Opportunities.

At the present time, it appears that there will be some type of potential cost relating to training requirements, but it is uncertain as to the magnitude of those requirements.

There will be additional work for the Commission on Human Rights and Opportunities associated with adoption of regulations. It is anticipated that this requirement can be handled within the normal budgetary resources of the Commission.

MUNICIPAL IMPACT: It is anticipated that there will be additional responsibility for municipalities as a result of the passage of this bill. Their responsibility depends to a great extent upon regulations developed by the state Commission on Human Rights and Opportunities.

At the present time, it appears that there will be some potential cost in getting supervisors trained in the area of sexual harrassment, but it is uncertain as to the magnitude of those requirements.
