EXPLANATION OF ESTIMATES:

STATE IMPACT: The passage of the bill as amended could result in a potential minimal cost to the Judicial Department and a potential minimal revenue gain to the State. To the extent that petitions would be filed (\$125 fee) with the court, minimal revenue and an increase in the caseload of the court would result. The costs related to such caseload are anticipated to be absorbable within normal budgetary resources.

House Amendment "A" makes several changes to the original bill but does not alter the fiscal impact.
