EXPLANATION OF ESTIMATES:

There is a potential cost to Legislative Management as a result of the passage of this bill, as amended, associated with the possibility of the task force using consultants. The actual cost of consultant services is unclear.

There will be no fiscal impact associated with the involvement of the Office of Policy and Management.

There may be some minimal cost associated with the production of a report by the task force.

House "B" removes the appointment of an Executive Director for the task force. It requires the Office of Fiscal Analysis to conduct the study in consultation with the Office of Policy and Management. It authorizes the task force to use consultants.

It makes changes in the membership of the task force.

The savings of eliminating an Executive Director may be offset by the potential cost of using a consultant.

Senate "A" revises the role of the Office of Fiscal Analysis and the Office of Policy and Management in the study. The study will be completed by the task force in consultation with the Office of Fiscal Analysis and the Office of Policy and Management. It has no fiscal impact.

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
