EXPLANATION OF ESTIMATES:

STATE IMPACT: The passage of this bill as amended would not result in a fiscal impact to the Division of Criminal Justice. Since the bill gives the Division the authority to give advice to criminal justice agencies, a current practice of the Division, no fiscal impact would result.

The bill as amended could, however, result in a minimal revenue gain to the State since it attaches a \$1,000 fine to attorneys who violate restrictions of confidentiality in certain cases.

House Amendment "A" attaches a \$1,000 fine to attorneys who violate certain terms of confidentiality and results in a potential minimal revenue gain to the State.
