EXPLANATION OF ESTIMATES:

STATE IMPACT: Since all funds for the State Department of Environmental Protection (DEP) Noise Pollution program were eliminated in the FY 92 budget, the DEP does not have any staff designated to work on noise pollution activities. Any increase in the caseload of the Judicial Department is anticipated to be minimal and absorbed within current resources.

MUNICIPAL IMPACT: Since the provisions of the bill concerning municipal action are discretionary, it is anticipated that any increase in workload attributed to towns seeking injunctions will be handled within available resources.
