EXPLANATION OF ESTIMATES:

STATE IMPACT: This bill as amended would allow the interagency task force studying electric and magnetic fields to recommend legislation to the legislature and requires a report by February 1, 1995 instead of an interim report by February 1, 1992. The task force is funded through a FY 1992 \$150,000 assessment on public utility companies and any additional work can be handled with remaining funds. Less than \$50,000 has been utilized thus far.

House "A" eliminated annual reports, reducing the number of reports and putting a deadline on the task force reports.
