EXPLANATION OF ESTIMATES:

STATE IMPACT: Passage of this bill gives Workers' Compensation Commissioners subpoena powers and the ability to impose a fine up to \$250 for those who fail to respond to subpoenas. The revenue gain anticipated from such fines is expected to be minimal.

The bill also prohibits payments from the Second Injury Fund to any injured employee who is employed by an out-of-state employer that is not required to pay assessments to the fund. This may result in a minimal savings to the fund.
