collective bargaining negotiations concerning wage changes as  
a result of objective job evaluations from July 1, 1992 to  
July 1, 1993 and extend the deadline for the elimination of  
wage inequities from June 30, 1993 to June 30, 1995.

EXPLANATION OF ESTIMATES:

STATE IMPACT: Existing statute requires that collective  
bargaining negotiations concerning wage changes  
resulting from objective job evaluations (OJE) occur  
after completion of OJE studies by the bargaining  
units. All of these studies have not been completed.  
Passage of this bill would delay associated personal  
services costs from fiscal 1993-94 to fiscal 1995-96.  
The first year costs are anticipated to be about \$50  
million with full year annualized costs in excess of  
\$100 million. Actual costs are contingent on the  
outcome of negotiations.
