EXPLANATION OF ESTIMATES:

STATE AND MUNICIPAL IMPACT: Since there will be constitutional amendments on the ballot in the 1992 general election, no immediate fiscal impact is anticipated to result from the passage of this resolution.

If the constitutional amendment is to be voted on at the 1994 election, costs associated with placing it on the ballot will be included in the agency's 1993-94 budget request. Typically, the costs range between \$10,000 and \$15,000.

The potential future effects of this proposed amendment, should it be adopted, cannot be known at this time.
