SUMMARY: This resolution approves an agreement between the Connecticut Department of Labor and the American Federation of State, County and Municipal Employees, AFL-CIO, Local 269, regarding overtime for certain positions.

EXPLANATION OF ESTIMATES:

STATE IMPACT: This resolution approves an agreement between the Connecticut Department of Labor and the American Federation of State, County and Municipal Employees, AFL-CIO, Local 269, regarding overtime for certain positions. The agreement specifies that retroactive to 11/17/91 through 6/30/92 employees within the classifications of Employment Security Senior Appeals Referee (Salary Range \$40,056-\$48,446), Employment Security Division Appeals referee (Salary Range \$36,371-\$44,186), Manager I- Job Service (Salary Range \$33,084-\$40,317) and Manager I- Unemployment Compensation (Salary Range \$33,084-\$40,317) will be compensated for all hours worked over thirty-five (35) at straight time.

There are approximately sixty (60) employees that fall within the specified classifications and they are all federally funded positions. To date these employees have worked approximately 7,780 hours overtime. As a result of this agreement they will receive \$193,000 in overtime pay and the state will be reimbursed approximately \$87,900 for fringe benefits. From April 10, 1992 through June 30, 1992, they are anticipated to work 2,130 overtime hours and receive an estimated \$46,500 in overtime pay. The state will be reimbursed approximately \$21,200 for fringe benefits.
