EXPLANATION OF ESTIMATES:

By permitting the Department of Revenue Services to require the electronic transfer of funds for taxpayers with tax liability over \$500,000, it will facilitate the State Treasurer's investment of such funds and increase investment earnings (or decrease the need to incur short-term interest costs) by an estimated \$300,000 in FY 1992-93 (half year) and \$600,000 in the future. The costs associated with implementing this activity are provided in SHB 5100 as favorably reported by the Appropriations Committee.

Senate "A" includes language of a clarifying nature and has no fiscal impact.

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
