EXPLANATION OF ESTIMATES:

Passage of this bill, as amended, would result in a minimal cost for the Department of Children and Youth Services, which can be absorbed by the resources of their normal operating budget. Since many of the costs associated with establishing official names for institutions and facilities, such as changes in street signs, placards, and stationery, have already been incurred, or are unnecessary in this instance, minimal additional costs are expected.

Also, the provision of the bill which refines the definition of a "person who is responsible for the health, welfare, or care of a child or youth" is a technical change to make state law consistent with federal regulations, which would result in no additional fiscal impact.

House "A" is a technical change providing for a statutory reference to the definition of "child day care services", which would result in no additional fiscal impact.
