EXPLANATION OF ESTIMATES:

STATE IMPACT: Passage of this bill as amended allows the Bureau of State-Wide Emergency Telecommunications to renew the certificates of telecommunicator instructors. Currently, they reapply when their certificates expire. The bill as amended also allows the Bureau to cancel or revoke telecommunicator and telecommunicator instructor certificates in certain circumstances and to adopt regulations. It appears that the Bureau can undertake these responsibilities at a minimal cost that can be absorbed because the bill as amended serves to clarify the Bureau's authority, and it is not anticipated that there will be many revocations.

The Governor's Revised Recommended Budget for 1992-93 eliminates the Bureau and transfers all three technical positions to the Department of Public Safety.

Senate "A", House "A" and "B" make technical changes and have no fiscal impact.
