EXPLANATION OF ESTIMATES:

MUNICIPAL IMPACT: The passage of this bill as amended would result in both potential minimal costs and potential cost avoidance to municipalities. To the extent that this bill as amended relieves municipalities of certain liabilities, a previously covered expense could now be avoided. The extent of the potential savings which could result from the avoidance of these liabilities is indeterminate. The bill as amended also allows municipal building officials to halt work on construction projects when workers do not have appropriate occupational licenses. Minimal costs could result from the requirement that orders to cease work must be sent in writing by certified mail to the holder of the building permit.

Senate Amendment "A" added the provision concerning municipal building officials and results in potential minimal costs.
