EXPLANATION OF ESTIMATES:

STATE IMPACT: The passage of the bill could result in a potential minimal revenue gain to the State. Under the bill, fines are increased by \$25 for violations of the prohibition against selling, giving or delivering tobacco products to those under age 18. In addition, the same fine is extended to those under 18 who purchase tobacco or misrepresent their age to purchase tobacco. The bill also attaches a \$100 fine to a violation of the requirement that cigarette dealers and distributors post a sign at the point of sale describing the state law prohibiting the sale of tobacco to minors. To the extent that violations of these requirements would occur, revenue would be gained.
