EXPLANATION OF ESTIMATES:

STATE IMPACT: The Judicial Department can anticipate a minimal workload increase for imposing fines to violators of the provisions of this bill. The number of potential violators is presently unknown, but is expected to be minimal. Thus, the additional expenditures associated with the implementation of the bill can be handled within available resources.

The revenue gain from the imposition of fines is expected to be minimal. However, it is unclear whether revenues would be placed in the Special Transportation Fund or the General Fund.
