EXPLANATION OF ESTIMATES:

STATE IMPACT: The passage of the bill would result in a potential cost, which can be absorbed, to the Probate Court Administration Fund (PCAF) which cannot be determined. The Probate Court Administration is a non-General Fund self-supporting agency.

Under the bill, the PCAF would be required to reasonably compensate conservators appointed by a probate court for their services. In addition, when a probate court waives the fees and costs involved in probate court proceedings for indigent applicants, the PCAF would be required to reimburse the individual probate courts. As the extent of these cases is unknown, the potential cost cannot be determined.

It should be noted that under the bill, the Probate Court Administrator would be responsible for establishing the rules and regulations related to the above costs. It is anticipated that these rules will require reimbursement within available funds.
