EXPLANATION OF ESTIMATES:

No cost is anticipated as a result of the bill as amended. Any expenses incurred to the Finance, Revenue and Bonding and Public Safety Committees which is associated with the feasibility study of authorizing additional casino gambling in the state is expected to be minimal and can be absorbed within existing budgetary resources.

Senate "A" removed the \$25,000 appropriation to Legislative Management for the task force to study the feasibility of casino gambling in Connecticut.

House "A" has no fiscal impact as it requires that the report be presented to the General Assembly by March 15, 1993.
