EXPLANATION OF ESTIMATES:

Elimination of the vision screening program would create savings to the Department of Motor Vehicles totalling \$271,250 broken down as follows: \$266,000 for the elimination of 14 budgeted but not yet filled, Permanent Full-Time positions (12 DMV Examiners and 2 Driver Improvement Analysts) and \$5,250 for Other Expenses. Since the program was to become fully operational by 10/1/92, the savings in FY 1993 represent three-quarter year funding.
