EXPLANATION OF ESTIMATES:

STATE IMPACT: Funding (\$40,150) and 1 position have been transferred from the Department of Administrative Services (DAS) to the Office of Policy and Management (OPM) within SA 92-13 (the Appropriations Act).

The bill authorizes the transfer of the Suggestion Award Program from DAS to OPM. (The budget instructs OPM to review the program in order to improve its effectiveness.)

The bill also requires the Commissioner of Administrative Services to directly charge the account of any State agency, without prior agency certification, for its expenses for telecommunications and related products. Within 30 days the agency must certify to the Comptroller that it used the service or obtained the products represented by the charge. This would have the effect of expediting the payment of Revolving Fund charges by State agencies. This would result in no additional cost.

Finally, the bill eliminates the Committee on Upward Mobility which has not met in five years. (It should be noted that a section of SHB 5571 as amended by House "A" expands the duties of the Committee on Upward Mobility, and requires it to meet at least 4 times per year).
