EXPLANATION OF ESTIMATES:

The interest cost to bond \$493,275,000 over twenty years at 6 3/4 percent is \$333,935,625.

Senate "A" authorizes an additional \$7 million for Department of Mental Retardation for land acquisition, construction or purchase and renovation of specialized group homes. Further, it provides a grant-in-aid to the Wallingford Housing Authority in the amount of \$220,000 for planning costs incurred for a congregate housing project. The lump sum authorization to DOH of \$54 million is reduced by the same amount. It also removes \$1,000,000 for the Department of Economic Development for creation of a Connecticut Center for Manufacturing Innovation. In addition, the amendment reauthorizes \$300,000 for improvements to Arute Field at Central Connecticut State University. It also makes technical changes to prior DOH authorizations with regard to the

Energy Conservation Loan Program. Finally, the amendment allows the Department of Public Works, with the approval of the Office of Policy and Management, to enter into lease purchase agreements for the development of a building for the DPUC and other related agencies.

Senate "B" authorizes an additional \$3 million for grants-in-aid to municipalities for new water mains to replace water supplied from contaminated wells.

Senate "C" and "D" make procedural changes and have no fiscal impact.

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
